Eligible Students

All students entering FAA Airframe and Powerplant Aviation Maintenance classes at Epic who are hired by Epic, and meeting other requirements as outlined below.

<u>Overview</u>

Epic Flight Academy is hiring aircraft mechanics and will sponsor training to become FAA licensed A&P mechanics who will work for the growing flight school.

Epic is filling both day and evening positions, with opportunities to travel to other locations throughout the United States.

If selected, Epic Flight Academy will cover 90% of the student's tuition, with opportunity for employment while in school. Students are required to pay 10% of tuition, purchase their own tools and pay for FAA exams. Once training is completed there are opportunities for long term growth including retention bonuses.

All students must meet all standard admission requirements.

If employed by Epic while in school, Epic will pay \$17/hour with FAA Airframe certificate, and then \$28/hour once both FAA A&P licenses are achieved. Students must take written, oral and practical exams within 60 days of completion of each course of study (General, Airframe, and Powerplant.)

Program Parameters

Students chosen for program will receive a conditional letter of hire and must sign a promissory note for the 90% tuition. If students leave before the 2-year anniversary of employment with Epic, they must pay back the tuition with 10% APR interest.

Students must remain in good standing with Epic while they are a student. This includes maintaining a good attendance record, earning good grades, full participation in class, and presence when expected.

Eligible students must have consistent, reliable transportation to attend Epic Flight Academy or be willing to relocate to New Smyrna Beach during training.
