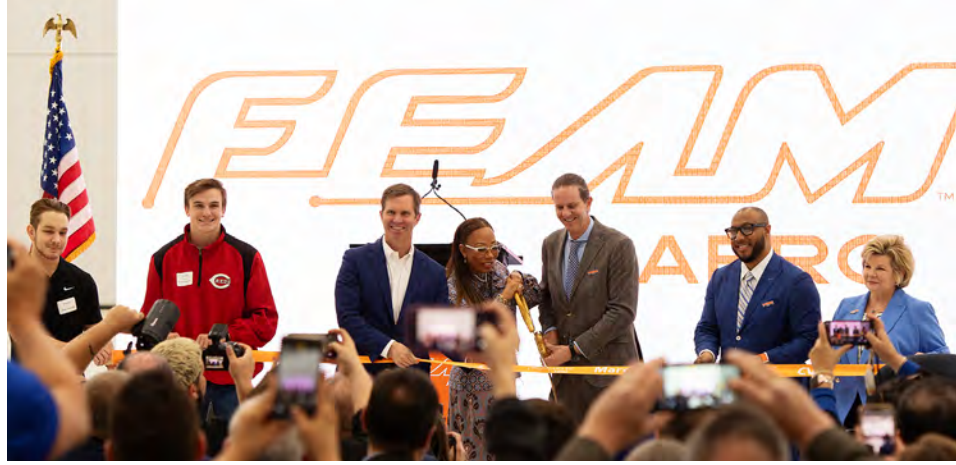

CVG Airport boosts workforce on campus

You may have seen the two new developments on campus that are fueling the workforce and bringing in more maintenance and repair services to the airport. Aviation maintenance, repair, and operations (MRO) company, FEAM Aero, opened its second hangar, a \$45 million investment, at CVG on March 28. More than 250 new jobs will be created with the opening of this facility.
